

Call for Nominations - Dealmaker of the Year Category

The Dealmakers of the Year Awards is Vancouver's premier annual award recognizing successful transactions in the M&A middle market. We are pleased to present awards to individuals and firms who have demonstrated the entrepreneurial skills and the diligence necessary to build a company's value and complete a successful exit transaction. Dealmakers is the opportunity to celebrate the achievements of British Columbia's M&A professionals and acknowledge industry excellence.

Dealmaker of the Year Nomination and Selection Criteria

The Dealmaker of the Year Award focuses on recognizing the contribution of an outstanding individual dealmaker who has contributed significantly to the prosperity of BC middle market companies through dealmaking.

Nomination Criteria

- Serial private company, middle market deal community participant resident in BC, having contributed significantly as principal or advisor to the prosperity of BC middle market companies through M&A, divestitures, joint ventures or strategic alliances
- Focus will be on transaction activity over the last two to three years, including significant activity in 2025
- Nominees may be a business owner, executive, transaction advisor, or financier/investor
- Nominees are to be individuals, not firms or companies more generally

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrated increase in shareholder value attributable to transaction activity
- Success relative to competitors and peers in prevailing market conditions
- Improved market position for their company or clients
- Creative structures, strategies or deal terms contributing to transaction value and/or risk mitigation
- Significant financial benefits as a result of the transactions (i.e. larger transactions weighted more heavily)
- Impact on BC's deal making community more broadly
