I think it expresses the emotion of the vineyard in a most extraordinary way- there is a lifted, almost ethereal quality to it, as those the red fruit notes are fluffy clouds- light red pillows if you will, which, for a vineyard sitting at 1260-foot elevation that often sits in the clouds, is perhaps as true to its origin as a wine can be.

2017 Holdredge Pinot Noir Bucher Vineyard

In a vintage in which high-toned red fruit dominated, the darker notes here were refreshing, but what I really loved was it still has that tell-tale note of rose petal in the aromatics.

Caymus Red Schooner Voyage 6 Malbec 2015

A dark reddish purple, Voyage 6 opens with lush earthiness on the nose, as scents of ripe plums mix with Medjool dates, wildflowers, suede leather and a fresh leafiness. Flavors of this wine follow its aromas, featuring ripe red plums, chocolate graham crackers, brown spice and soft leather. Tannins are smooth and cool, providing an unusual softness. A wisp of smokiness on the finish creates an alluring entreaty to return for another sip.

Deep red with an intense purple hue. Black cherry, violet, and licorise nose. The palate follows again with black cherry and dark plum. These dark fruits balance perfectly with the sumptuous, French oak. The finish has supple, round tannins with a massive amount of fruit.

Light pale color yet still has a vibrancy to it. Looks more like Chablis than a Russian River Chardonnay, but on the nose, it shows distinct tones like those from the Côte de Beaune — there were notes reminding me of coconut, lemon cream, crème brûlée, grapefruit, green tea and vanilla bean.

It is a blend of sixty percent Loubejac fruit, thirty percent Yamhill and ten percent Eyrie, and this is Seth's only 2017 chardonnay bottling that saw more than a dollop of new oak, as this was raised in forty-

five percent new casks. The wine comes in at an even thirteen percent octane and was bottled unfinned and unfiltered. It delivers marvelous aromatic sophistication in its blend of pear, white peach, almond, salty soil tones, dried flowers and vanillin oak. On the palate the wine is deep, full and very elegant in profile, with a superb core of fruit, lovely soil signature, bright acids and a long, complex and gently new oaky finish. This is really a delicious bottle of chardonnay that will age long and gracefully, but is a tad less tightlyknit out of the blocks than the 2016 version was in its youth and it is going to make it that much harder to keep one's hands off of the 2017 Sandi and let it blossom with extended cellaring! 2019-2045." 8/19

Spring Mountain Vineyard Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2015

95 Points, James Molesworth, Wine Spectator: "Sports an intense and pure beam of raspberry and cassis flavors, flanked by sage, incense and black tea aromas and backed by mouthwatering licorice snap notes and a bramble-filled finish. 95-97 Points, Jeb Dunnuck, jebdunnuck.com: "Domaine Charvin Châteauneuf-du-Pape RED) Not yet bottled, the 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape from Laurent Charvin is a beauty, and I'd wager one of the finest to date. In addition, it has a vibrant, mineral-laced personality that I'm sure is loved by Laurent. As classic as it gets, with a rocking bouquet of black, black fruits, garrigue, crushed rocks, and pepper, it hits the palate with full-bodied richness, remarkable concentration, yet also the freshness and purity that's the hallmark of Laurent's wines. I followed this bottle for two days, and it shut down with extended aeration, so I'd recommend trying a bottle on release and then hiding the rest for a good 4-5 years. The blend is the classic 82% Grenache, 5% each of Mourvèdre and Syrah, and the balance Vaccarèse and Cunoise, fermented with 100% whole clusters and aged all in concrete tanks. Don't miss this beauty. One of my favorite estates is Laurent Charvin's Domaine Charvin. This estate is located in the cooler, northern part of Châteauneuf-du-Pape and you'll be hard pressed to find a harder working vigneron out there. These are as traditional as it gets, and the wines are not stemmed, spend upward of three weeks on skins with pumpovers, and are aged all in concrete tanks. The wines always lean more toward the fresher, more elegant side of the spectrum yet rarely lack for depth of fruit and texture. They (Côtes du Rhône included) age beautifully, and true Southern Rhône lovers need to have these wines in their cellars." 8/18

92 Points, Antonio Galloni, Vinous Media: "Occidental Pinot Noir (freestone Occidental) (formerly Sonoma Coast) Sonoma Red) The 2016 Pinot Noir (Freestone Occidental) is a very pretty wine. Expressive floral and savory notes lead into a core of bright red-toned fruits. Silky and medium in body, with lovely aromatic presence, the 2016 is absolutely gorgeous today. 89 Points, Neal Martin, Wine Advocate: "Tasted blind at the Bordeaux 2012 Southwold tasting. The 2012 La Croix de Beaucaillou has a reserved but clean and focused bouquet of earthy black fruit, tobacco and a touch of bay leaf. It just needs a little more vigor. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin. There is an attractive pencil lead note, fine balance with quite a long tail on the finish. This has to be one of the best wines ever produced at Altos Las Hormigas. It has the balance to develop nicely in bottle. 10,208 bottles produced. It was bottled in February 2018." 6/18
